## District News

### Encampment Enforcement Ordinance Update

On Wednesday, December 14, Sacramento Mayor Steinberg presented a proposed new ordinance that would limit the current protocols for moving or towing an occupied vehicle, allowing occupied vehicles to stay in place until more sheltering services become available. In a 6/3 vote, the Council amended the ordinance to allow more transparency and time to find viable solutions.

#### Going Forward

The new ordinance calls for city staff to report areas slated for outreach and cleanup before posting vehicles for tow. The Department of Community Response, the Homeless Impact Team, and city staff will continue to visit camps to find shelter and services for our unhoused.

City Council also called on business communities to help find viable locations for

sheltering and services. For the past two years, Power Inn Alliance and our partnering business coalitions have been seeking lots and facilities that will fill the requirements.

## **The Future is The Hub of Innovation**

The Power Inn District is becoming a regional hub for innovation. Among the new businesses and expansion projects, The Hub in the Sacramento Center for Innovation (SCI area) is exciting new landmark projects located on 25 acres on the northeast side of Ramona Avenue.

Led by Sacramento State University, The Hub will be home to a new CA Mobility Center (CMC) and a CA Department of Justice (DOJ) facility.

CMC is a partnership of transportation agencies blending research and development for new mobility options. The DOJ plans to build a new high tech training school and forensics lab, linked with Sac State's Criminal Justice program.

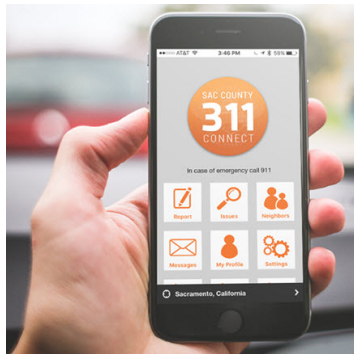
## RydeFree-RT Funded and Extended for a Third Year

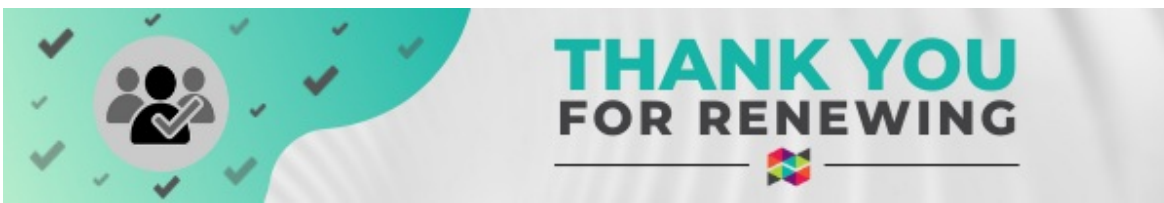
